Hawaiian Welcomes First Flight from Brisbane, Australia

Hawaiian Airlines welcomed to Honolulu its first nonstop flight from Brisbane, Australia. The 229 passengers were greeted upon arrival in the tradition of the islands with fresh flower lei, Hawaiian music and hula.

Hawaiian is the only U.S. carrier serving Brisbane, capital city of the State of Queensland, and is offering nonstop flights, three days weekly, to and from Honolulu.

Hawaiian's Brisbane service is adding 41,000 new air seats to the market annually and will generate for Hawai'i's visitor industry an estimated \$79 million in visitor expenditures and \$8.6 million in state tax

revenue, according to the Hawai'i Tourism Authority (HTA).

The Honolulu-Brisbane flights will also make it easier for travelers in Hawai'i and North America to experience the scenic beauty of Queensland, popularly known as Australia's "Sunshine State."

Centrally located on Australia's east coast, Brisbane is the gateway to a host of appealing sites and attractions for visitors to enjoy, including the world-famous Great Barrier Reef, world heritage listed rainforests, the iconic Outback territory, and the renowned leisure destinations of Australia's Gold and Sunshine Coasts.



Brisbane is also a key hub for onward travel throughout Australia. Capitalizing on this, Hawaiian has timed its flight schedule for travelers to connect with same-day flights to and from throughout Queensland and other states via an interline partnership with domestic carrier Virgin Australia.

Hawaiian's Flight HA 443 departs Honolulu at 10:20 a.m. every Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday, crosses the international dateline, and arrives in Brisbane at 4:00 p.m. the following day.

The return flight HA 444 departs Brisbane at 6:35 p.m. every Wednesday, Friday and Sunday, crosses the international dateline, and arrives in Honolulu at 8:05 a.m. the same day.

Hawaiian is offering the comfort and roominess of its wide-body, twin-aisle Boeing 767-300ER aircraft to operate the Honolulu-Brisbane route, seating 264 passengers in a two-class cabin, with 18 in Business Class and 246 in the Main Cabin.

Hawaiian's signature 'Mea Ho'okipa' (translation: I am host) onboard service adds to the enjoyment of the travel experience with its celebration of the culture, people, and Aloha Spirit of the Hawaiian Islands throughout the flight.

Brisbane is the seventh of eight new destinations that Hawaiian has introduced or announced new service to since November 2010, following Tokyo, Osaka, Fukuoka, and Sapporo, Japan; Seoul, South Korea; and New York City. Hawaiian will launch service to Auckland, New Zealand, on March 13, 2013.


Hawaiian Airlines CEO Signs New Three-Year Contract Extension

American Medical Association (AMA) delegates gathered in Hawai'i last week for the AMA Interim Meeting from Nov. 8-10, 2012, at the Hawai'i Convention Center. In honor of the meeting, Hawai'i Gov. Neil Abercrombie (center) presented a proclamation on Nov. 9, 2012, declaring "American Medical Association Week." The meeting is part of a strong year-end lineup of medical and scientific gatherings at the Hawai'i Convention Center. From Oct. 7-12, 2012, the Pacific Rim Meeting on Electrochemical and Solid-State Science drew a record 4,000 attendees. In August, the Center hosted the Asia Pacific Clean Energy Summit and Expo; in May more than 14,500 attendees gathered for the American Association of Orthodontists (AAO) 112th Annual Session, and more than 1,000 attendees participated in the 31st-annual American Pain Society scientific meeting. That follows on the heels of five major medical and scientific meetings at the Center in 2011 that attracted a combined 30,000 participants. The Center will host the American Heart Association International Stroke Conference from Feb. 6-8, 2012.



In what is now an annual tradition to celebrate the holiday season, Sheraton Princess Kaiulani is featuring its annual Santa's Gingerbread Village from now to January 2 in the resort's lobby. Guests and kama'aina are invited to visit Executive Chef Ralf Bauer's edible winter wonderland made of gingerbread and other sweet treats themed "Hawaii and the World, a Global Holiday Celebration."

In what started as a replication of the holiday scenery of a quaint mountainside village of his native Germany, Bauer's creation includes medieval churches, bell towers, train stations, a carousel, a skating rink, German Village with its castle and Swiss Chalet and Alps. After years of perfecting the gingerbread buildings and adding new and amazing structures, the Gingerbread Village now includes such iconic Hawaii landmarks such as Kawaiahao Mission Church, Moana Surfrider, Iolani Palace and Aloha Tower. As his creative appetite grows each year, this year's Gingerbread Village will also include world-famous landmarks such as the Eiffel Tower from France, the Tower Bridge from London, and a Japanese Pagoda – all made from gingerbread and icing!

This year, Chef Bauer, Pantry Chef Amie Tungpalan, Executive Sous Chef John Hightower and the hotel's engineering department will likely spend over 800 hours designing, constructing and setting up the final art piece. The gingerbread village, which will stand over 14.5 feet high and over 24 feet wide, will be constructed with 250 gallons of icing, 150 pounds of dark chocolate, 50 pounds of white chocolate, and 90 sheets of gingerbread. "Every year, we look forward to seeing the children's joy as they discover every detail of the village," said Chef Bauer. "Visitors from all over the world come to Hawaii to see our gingerbread wonderland and experience the traditional Christmas atmosphere with the island's touch of Aloha."


