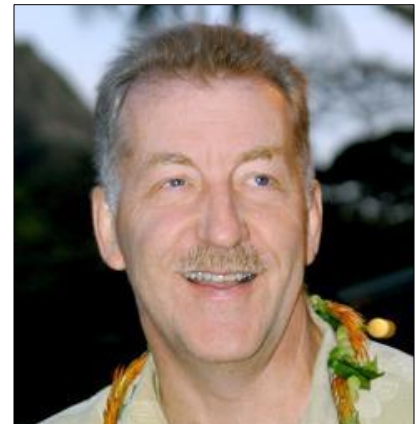

8th Annual Hapa Haole Competition Winners to Perform with the Royal Hawaiian Band

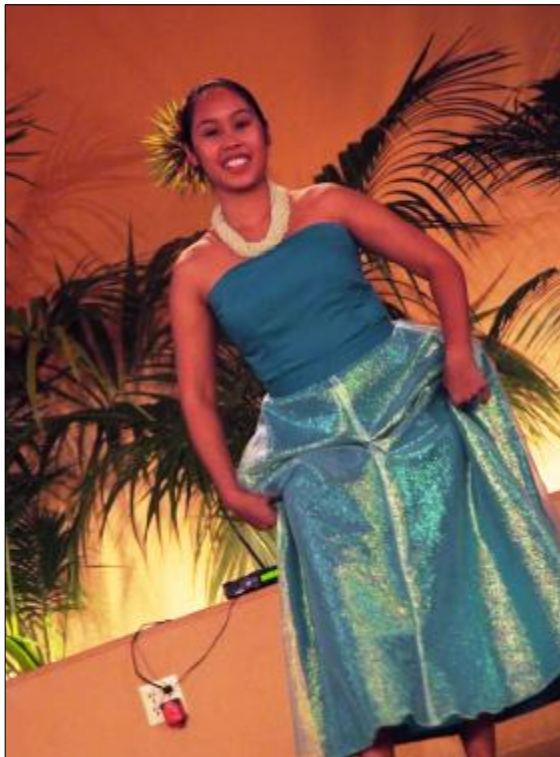
Sunday, October 10, 2010 2pm, Kapi'olani Park Bandstand

Each year over 1000+ paddlers from around the world compete in the Moloka'i Hoe, the men's world championship in outrigger canoe racing and the crossing of the treacherous Ka'iwi Channel.

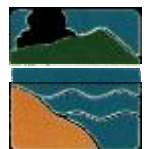
